Our Commitment

WCF Ltd is committed to conducting its activities in a responsible and sustainable manner that protects the environment, supports local communities, and contributes to a low-carbon future. We recognise that our operations across fuel distribution, retail, leisure, e-commerce fulfilment and related services have environmental impacts, and we are committed to managing and reducing these wherever reasonably practicable.

We believe that good environmental management strengthens our business, reduces risk, improves efficiency, and enhances our reputation with customers, suppliers, employee-owners, regulators, and wider stakeholders.

Legal Compliance

WCF Ltd commits to full compliance with all applicable environmental legislation, regulations, and statutory requirements relevant to our activities. This includes, where applicable, obligations relating to:

- Pollution prevention and environmental protection
- Waste management and duty of care
- Storage and handling of fuels, oils, and hazardous substances
- Energy use and carbon reporting
- Packaging and producer responsibility
- Water protection
- Transport and vehicle emissions

As a large entity, WCF Ltd complies with the Energy Savings Opportunity Scheme (ESOS) and Streamlined Energy and Carbon Reporting (SECR) requirements. We maintain appropriate systems and processes to identify legal obligations, monitor compliance, and respond promptly to any breaches or incidents.

Climate, Carbon & Resource Efficiency

We recognise the urgency of climate change and the UK's legally binding commitment to net zero. We measure and report our Scope 1 and Scope 2 greenhouse gas emissions and have mapped our Scope 3 emissions with external specialist support. We are actively developing a credible, phased pathway to net zero.

We aim to reduce our environmental footprint by:

- Improving fuel efficiency and optimising vehicle routing using best available technology
- Maintaining our fleet, plant and properties through planned inspection, servicing and remediation
- Investing in energy-efficient technologies
- Evaluating opportunities to adopt renewable energy sources
- Reducing energy and water consumption
- Eliminating unnecessary single-use plastics
- Increasing reuse and recycling

Pollution Prevention & Risk Management

We are committed to preventing pollution to air, land, and water. We do this by:

- Maintaining robust emergency response and spill control procedures
- Using hazardous materials only where necessary and minimising their use
- Ensuring safe storage, handling and transportation of fuels and chemicals
- Training colleagues on environmental risks relevant to their roles
- Regularly reviewing our controls and procedures

Our People & Culture

We believe that environmental responsibility is a shared commitment. We:

- Provide colleagues with appropriate training and awareness
- Encourage sustainable working practices, including reduced travel and responsible resource use
- Promote environmentally positive behaviours, such as cycling to work and recycling
- Embed environmental considerations into everyday decision-making

We recognise that many of our environmental impacts occur within our supply chain. We will:


- Encourage our suppliers and partners to adopt good environmental practices
